Workshop and accommodations are in the Petrozavodsk city. The organizing committee can help and advise in booking hotels if needed.

The registration fee is

- 1000 rub for a participant whose talk represents Russian organization
- 700 rub for participant whose talk represents Karelian organization and
- 100 euro for other participants.

The fee includes preparation of invitations to Russia, coffee breaks, ceremonial banquet (additionally 1000 rub or 25 euro), local transport (by bus), renting auditoriums and equipment, registration in Russia, administration, and organizational expenses. Payments must be in rubles.
